In these challenging economic times, affordable family attractions are bordering on extinction.

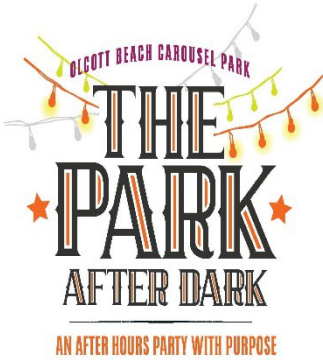
